

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Tuesday, June 12, 2018

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Chuck Pajer, Al Winters, Randy Conrad, Russ Brandau, Barb Francis and Steve Thompson (Media). Motion by Voaklander, second by Smolik to delete County Attorney and manure management plan updates and to approve the amended agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Smolik, second by Voaklander to approve the minutes of the June 5th meeting and the claims. Roll call vote: all vote aye.

Sheriff Greg Beaver reported that an arrest has been made in the Pinicon Alders Cabin case.

County Engineer Rich Brumm reported on the flooding of roads from last week's rain. Rich recommended that the Board approve the hiring of Ben Hartogh as a new mechanic at the Secondary Roads department. Motion by Voaklander, second by Smolik to approve the hiring of Ben Hartogh. His hire date is June 25, 2018 and his rate of pay is \$21.38 per hour. Roll call vote: all ayes. Rich reviewed the contract for design service for the Stacyville Bridge. Motion by Smolik, second by Voaklander to accept the contract from WHKS in the amount of \$42,000 for the Stacyville Bridge Project. Roll call vote: all ayes. Discussed a request from the St. John's Lutheran Church Board to pave 390th Street one mile to Balsam Avenue. No action was taken. Also discussed rumble strips and ordering "jake brake" signs for along the Osage truck route. Rich will order the signs. Secondary Roads will be getting the generator from the County Care Facility.

Motion by Voaklander, second by Walk to approve Resolution #1015-18 authorizing and approving a certain Loan Agreement, providing for the issuance of \$1,200,000 Taxable General Obligation County Urban Renewal Bonds, Series 2018 and providing for the levy of taxes to pay the same. Roll call vote: Voaklander and Walk voted aye. Smolik abstained. Motion carried.

Items of note: Voaklander reported on the Valent meeting. Smolik reported on the NIVC and Fair Board meetings. Walk reported on the NIACOG meeting.

The Board declared themselves as a Board of Canvassers and proceeded to canvas the votes of the Mitchell County Primary Election held June 5, 2018. Candidates nominated are as follows:
