

RESOLUTION #111

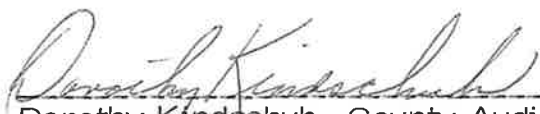
Whereas, The Mitchell County Board of Supervisors proposes to vacate and close a section of Mitchell County Secondary Roads described as follows:

1. Beginning at the S.W. corner of Section 18, T98N, R18W of the 5th P.M., thence east along the south line of said Section 18 to the S.E. corner of Section 18, a distance of approximately 1.0 miles.
2. Beginning at the S.W. corner of Section 20, T99N, R16W of the 5th P.M., thence east along the south line of said Section 20 to the S.E. corner of Section 20, a distance of approximately 1.0 miles.
3. Beginning at the S.W. corner of Section 7, T100N, R15W of the 5th P.M., thence north along the west line of said Section 7 to the N.W. corner of Section 7, a distance of approximately 0.9 miles.

A hearing on the proposed vacation will be held in the Board Room, Mitchell County Courthouse, Osage, Iowa 50461, at 1:30 P.M., C.D.T., on Monday, September 12, 1983, in accordance with the 1981 Code of Iowa, Chapter 306.

NOTICE OF HEARING

IN RE: VACATING MITCHELL COUNTY ROADS.

TO: WHOM IT MAY CONCERN.

The Mitchell County Board of Supervisors, acting under the authority of Chapter 306, 1981 Code of Iowa, propose to vacate sections of Mitchell County Secondary Roads, described as follows:—

1. Beginning at the S.W. corner of Section 18, T98N, R18W of the 5th P.M., thence east along the south line of said Section 18 to the S.E. corner of Section 18, a distance of approximately 1.0 miles.
2. Beginning at the S.W. corner of Section 20, T99N, R16W of the 5th P.M., thence east along the south line of said Section 20 to the S.E. corner of Section 20, a distance of approximately 1.0 miles.
3. Beginning at the S.W. corner of Section 7, T100N, R15W of the 5th P.M., thence north along the west line of said Section 7 to the N.W. corner of Section 7, a distance of approximately 0.9 miles.

A hearing will be held by the Mitchell County Board of Supervisors in their office, Mitchell County Courthouse, Osage, Iowa 50461, at 1:30 P.M. C.D.T., on Monday, September 12, 1983. Any interested person may appear and object and be heard. Any person owning land abutting on the road proposed to be vacated and closed shall have the right to file, in writing, a claim for damages at any time on or before the date and time fixed for the hearing.
