

RESOLUTION #117

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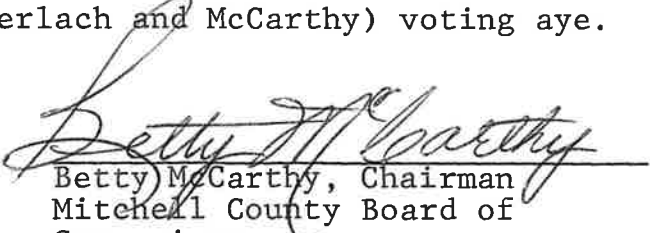
The Mitchell County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on January 26, 1984. Motion Mayer, seconded Gerlach to pass the following resolution:

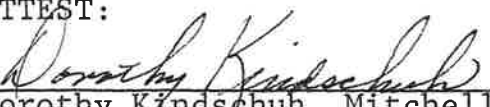
WHEREAS, hearing was held as required by law at the appointed time and no objections were filed or voiced,
