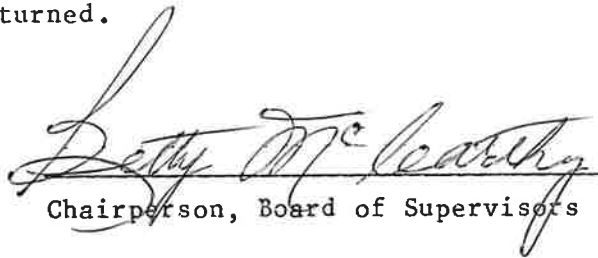


RESOLUTION #134

WHEREAS, lawsuits against counties arising out of claims of road signing deficiencies, road defects, false arrest, malicious prosecution, assault and battery, excessive force during arrest and civil rights violations are of grave and mutual concern to all Iowa counties, and

WHEREAS, it is of mutual benefit for all Iowa counties to cooperate, one with the other, to insure that there is comprehensive liability insurance, at a reasonable premium, available to all Iowa counties to protect counties against these claims, provide for a coordinated defense for the counties, and to aid the counties in recognizing and correcting problems in these areas before claims arise,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY Mitchell County:
That Mitchell County does hereby contribute the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) to County Risk Management Services of the Iowa State Association of Counties to be by it used to aid in providing comprehensive liability insurance against these claims, a coordinated defense to these claims, and to provide information, help, and educational material to the counties concerning these claims, and the Auditor shall draw and execute a warrant of this county in this amount and forward it to the Iowa State Association of Counties, 1055 - 6th Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa 50314 to be placed in an escrow account until the aggregate received by December 31, 1984 equals \$500,000.00. If it does not, this assessment will be returned.
