

RESOLUTION #154

Regarding placement of embargoes on certain Farm to Market roads in Mitchell County, Iowa.

Whereas, the Mitchell County Board of Supervisors recognizes the effect caused by winter conditions on certain paved roads during the period of thawing this spring, and

Whereas, Section 321.471 and 321.473 of the 1985 Code of Iowa provide the authority for local authorities to impose restrictions as to the weight of vehicles to be operated on any highway under their jurisdiction and Section 321.463 establishes the penalty for violating said restrictions,

Now Therefore Be It Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Mitchell County, Iowa, that the following weight restrictions are in effect for the period of 90 days from March 27, 1986, or until rescinded by the removal of signs by the proper authorities.

5 - Ton Axle Limit (Gross Load $\pm$ Number of Axles x 5 tons.)

T-26 From S.E. Cor. Sec. 13-97-18 north to Iowa No. 9.

T-40 From Stacyville north to the Minnesota State line.

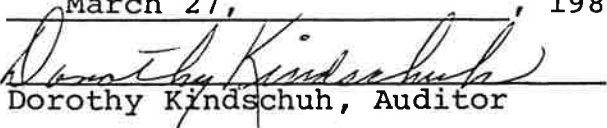
S-70 From S.E. Cor. Sec. 18-97-18 north to Iowa No. 9.

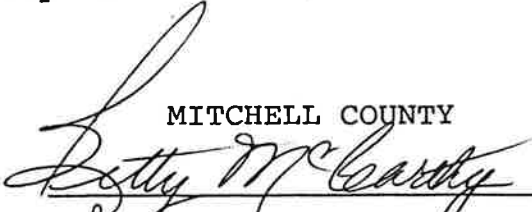
A-23 From Stacyville east to McIntire.

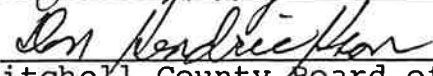
A-31 From N.E. Cor. Sec. 22-99-16 east to N.E. Cor. Sec. 22-99-15.

Said embargoes to be in effect when signs are posted advising the public and the County Engineer is authorized to have signs placed and/or removed as road and weather conditions require.
