which was acquired by Mitchell County at tax sale be sold at public auction on the following terms and conditions.

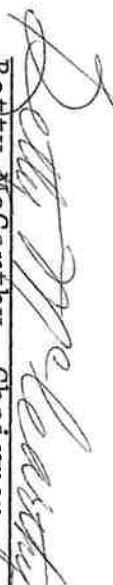
1. Sale will be by quit claim deed.

3. The purchase price shall be payable in full upon delivery of a quit claim deed to the successful bidder.

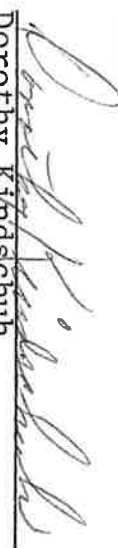
4. Sale shall be held in the office of the Mitchell County Board of Supervisors on the 4th day of Sept., 1986, at 9:30 o'clock A. m.
