

RESOLUTION NO. 169

RESOLUTION DETERMINING ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS FOR THE 1987 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM AND ORDERING THE PUBLICATION OF NOTICE TO PUBLIC OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT ON THE ENVIRONMENT AND NOTICE TO PUBLIC OF REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS.

WHEREAS, Mitchell County, Iowa is undertaking a Community Development Project under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act and has reviewed and assessed the environmental impact for said project.

WHEREAS, after conducting appropriate reviews, the Mitchell County Board of Supervisors has determined that said Project is not a Major Federal Action significantly affecting the quality of human life;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLES CITY, IOWA,

1. That said project has no significant effect on the environment, said decision being based on the following facts and reasons:
(a) Assessment of the nature, magnitude and duration of the adverse and positive impact; (b) Consideration of: alternatives to the projects, commitment of resources, known views of local groups, measures which can be instituted to lessen potential adverse impact and to enhance the environment; (c) No loss of unique environmental resources; (d) No irreversible development trends; (e) A minimum occurrence of effect that cannot be avoided; (f) No impact on properties possessing historical, archeological, architectural or cultural significance.
 2. That the Project Environmental Review Records be placed on file in the office of the County Auditor, where said records may be examined and/or copied by any interested individual, group or agency;
 3. That is proposes to conduct no additional environmental review of said projects and intends to request that the Department of Housing and Urban Development release funds for said projects;
 4. That a Public Notice of the Findings of No Significant Effect on the environment be published and disseminated as required.

WHEREAS, the County Board of Supervisors, acting on behalf of Mitchell County, Iowa as applicant for Community Development funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act has completed all applicable environmental review and clearance procedures.

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Board of Supervisors to submit a request to the Iowa Department of Economic Development (DED) for the release of Title I funds for the aforementioned project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA,

1. That the Environmental Review Records for the aforementioned project continue on file in the office of County Auditor until May 15, 1987 where said records may be examined and/or copies by any interested individual, group or agency;
2. That upon the 15th day of May, 1987 a request will be submitted to DED by the County for release of funds and certification to undertake the aforementioned project and upon receipt of the Request for Release of Funds, DED will allow a minimum of 15 days for comments by the public.
3. That the Chairperson is hereby authorized to consent to assume the status of a responsible federal official, under NEPA, insofar as the provisions of NEPA apply to HUD responsibilities for review, decision making and action assumed and carried out by the City as to environmental issues;
4. That the Chairperson is hereby authorized to consent personally, in his official capacity and on behalf of the County to accept the jurisdiction of the federal courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to environmental reviews, decision making and action;
5. That the Chairperson is hereby authorized to execute a Certification pursuant to the aforementioned matters and addressed to the authorized OPP officer;
6. That a public notice of the request for release of funds be published.
BOARD MEMBER Mayer moved the adoption of the foregoing Resolution; BOARD MEMBER Hendrickson seconded the motion and on roll call the voting was as follows:
