

RESOLUTION NO. 181

Whereas, the Mental Health Center of North Iowa has a critical space problem with the present building due to a continual increase in the demand for mental health services during the past several years in the nine (9) county area they were created to serve, and

Whereas, this space problem must be resolved with due haste to avoid severe detractions from service levels, and

Whereas, the most expeditious and economical solution is to construct additional space thereby enlarging the existing structure, and

Whereas, the State of Iowa has available financial assistance ideally suited to such projects entitled the Community Development Block Grant Program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY THAT: Mitchell County supports and commits to co-sponsor an application for Community Development Block Grant Funds to construct additional building space, drainage, and parking that is desperately needed at the Mental Health Center of North Iowa, which serves the mental health service needs of Mitchell County.
