Whereas, the Chemical Dependency Services of North Iowa has a critical space problem with the present building due to a continual increase in the demand for substance abuse treatment services during the past several years in the eight (8) county area they were created to serve, and

Whereas, this space problem must be resolved with due haste to avoid severe detractions from service levels, and

Whereas, the most expeditious and economical solution is to construct a new facility to house the Chemical Dependency Services of North Iowa administrative and treatment services, and

Whereas, the State of Iowa has available financial assistance ideally suited to such projects entitled the Community Development Block Grant Program,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY THAT: Mitchell County supports an application for Community Development Block Grant Funds to construct a new facility to house the Chemical Dependency Services of North Iowa, which services the substance abuse treatment needs of Mitchell County.
