

## **PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA**

The Board of Supervisors and the Mitchell Conservation Board held a joint meeting at the Nature Center. The meeting convened at 1:00 p.m. with all members present. Also present were the Conservation Board, Director Adam Shirley, Sheriff Greg Beaver and Recorder Pat Skuster.

The proposed wage increases for the Director and the full-time employees were discussed. Supervisor Voaklander asked if the Board could explain why the wage proposals were over and above the 3% what the BOS had approved for the rest of the county employees. The Board stated that they had done research and comparisons with other Conservation departments thru out the state of Iowa. The Board feels that the raises they proposed are justified. Also discussed plans for the Mitchell Dam. Revenues from the dam will stay with the project.
