

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Tuesday, August 4, 2015

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with Paulus and Voaklander present. Walk was attending another meeting. Also present were Chuck Pajer and Deb Nicklay (Media). Motion by Voaklander, second by Paulus to include Osage Bowl and to approve the amended agenda. All voted aye.

County Attorney Mark Walk and County Engineer Brumm a proposed FEMA Ordinance for future flood issues. Also discussed policy for field drive ways, cleanup progress of the Duane Tesch property in Toeterville and county funding for the County Rural Libraries.

Tom Madden stated that he had met with Valent management regarding the odor study. More to follow.

County Engineer Rich Brumm reported that the paving project between Stacyville and McIntire will be completed the week of August 10th. Shoulder is being done on what has been paved.

Sheriff Greg Beaver is recommending Susan Martin be hired as a PRN Jailer at a starting wage of \$18.08 per hour with a six month probation. Her hire date will be August 10, 2015. Motion by Paulus, second by Voaklander to approve the hire. Roll call vote: all ayes.

Discussed a request from the Osage Bowl to hold an outdoor concert on their premises the evening of August 21, 2015. The Auditor will check with the Alcoholic Beverages Division to see if Osage Bowl has requested to have an outdoor service added to their license. No action was taken.

Motion by Voaklander, second by Paulus to approve the minutes of the July 28th meeting. Roll call vote: all ayes.

Motion by Voaklander, second by Paulus to approve fireworks permits for Ron Heuton for the evening of August 7th and Joel D. Nickerson the evening of August 14th or 15th. Roll call vote: all ayes.

Items of note: Received manure management plan updates from Friesen Farms – Northeast and Larry Bissen. Supervisor Paulus is scheduling a courthouse security meeting. The grand opening scheduled for August 29th will be postponed to a later date.
