

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Friday, September 16, 2016

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:00 a.m. with all members present. Motion by Paulus, second by Walk to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

The Board considered themselves as a Board of Canvassers and proceeded to canvas the votes of the special Osage Community School election held on Tuesday, September 13, 2016. Votes for a vacancy on the School Board were as follows: Angela Nasstrom received 870 votes and Larry Plotzke received 450 votes. Nasstrom was declared the winner. For Public Measure "A" for the Board of Directors of the Osage School District be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$14,900,000 for a building project. There were 648 yes votes and 708 no votes. The Public Measure didn't receive the required 60% approval and was declared defeated. Motion by Voaklander, second by Paulus to accept the canvas and to sign the official canvass. Roll call vote: all ayes.

Discussed the Family Medical Leave Act and how it affects the Mitchell County employee's monthly flex benefit dollars.
