

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Tuesday, September 20, 2016

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Chuck Pajer, Ken Grimm and Jim Cross (Media). Motion by Voaklander, second by Paulus to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Tom Madden reported that parts for the scrubbers at the Valent pretreatment plant will be installed this week.

Sheriff Greg Beaver presented the Sheriff report for August. Motion by Paulus, second by Voaklander to approve the report in the amount of \$12,907.14. Roll call vote: all ayes.

County Engineer Rich Brumm stated the Balsam Bridge is to be open today, Jersey Avenue will be rocked this week and construction of the salt shed at St. Ansgar will start soon. Discussed a proposal to replace stop signs with yield signs along Noble Avenue. Ken Grimm, who lives along Noble Avenue, addressed the Board and requested that the stop signs remain at the intersections. Noble Avenue is a farm-to-market road and has a traffic count less than 80. He stated that it would be a waste of money and resources to change the signs. Motion by Paulus to stop the consideration of removing the stop signs and replacing them with yield signs. Motion died for a lack of a second. No other action was taken.

Motion by Voaklander, second by Paulus to approve the minutes of the September 12th, 13th and 16th meetings. Roll call vote: all ayes.

Motion by Paulus, second by Voaklander to approve a liquor license for the Osage Bowl and Crossover Restaurant. Roll call vote: all ayes.

Conservation Director Adam Shirley reported on county property's that the Conservation Board is interested in acquiring. The Rendezvous is scheduled for the weekend of September 24th. Discussed the future of the Stacyville Park.

Items of note: Voaklander reported on the Prairie Ridge and FMC Landfill meetings and Walk reported on the Homeward Housing meeting. Received the August Clerk of Court report in the amount of \$3,360.62.
