Tuesday, August 1, 2017

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Randy Conrad and Crystal Berche (Media). Motion by Paulus, second Walk to delete pretreatment plant update and to approve the amended agenda. All voted aye.

County Attorney Mark Walk discussed the proposed Purple Heart Proclamation.

Motion by Paulus, second by Walk to approve the minutes of the July 25th meeting. Roll call vote: all ayes.

County Engineer Rich Brumm stated that culvert on 440th Street will soon be completed. Grading work on Jersey Avenue will be completed the second week of August. Rich is working on plans for the Hwy 105 and Zinna Avenue projects.

Sheriff Greg Beaver stated that the Stacyville Brat Days went well.

One bid was received for the sale of Sheriff Departments Dodge Durango. David Kling bid \$1,467.00. After discussion, it was decided to table taking any action on the sale of the vehicle.

Motion by Walk, second by Paulus to deny issuing a fireworks permit to James Hansen due to the fact that the fireworks would be displayed inside the city limits of St. Ansgar. Roll call vote: all ayes.

Mitchell County Veterans Affairs Director Larry Klemesrud reviewed a Proclamation proclaiming Mitchell County as "A Purple Heart County". Motion by Paulus, second by Walk to approve the Proclamation request. Roll call vote: all ayes.

Items of note: Voaklander reported on the County Social Services meeting. Received a manure management plan update from the Brynes Site.

Discussed doing a walk thru of the County Care Facility building. A decision on the building will be made at the September 12th meeting.
