

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Tuesday, June 20, 2017

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Chuck Pajer, Randy Conrad, Adam Shirley Nathan Johnson (Media). Motion by Paulus, second Walk to include can redemption, delete pretreatment plant update to approve the amended agenda. All voted aye.

County Attorney Mark Walk stated that the pit bull incident in the City of Mitchell is progressing. Discussed the ruling by the Iowa Supreme Court on weapons in courtrooms.

Sheriff Greg Beaver reviewed the May Sheriff report. Motion by Paulus, second by Walk to approve the report in the amount of \$6,536.69. Roll call vote: all ayes

County Engineer Rich Brumm stated that he had a meeting last week for the RISE paving project and a meeting with Grain Miller officials for the Hwy 105 paving project. Grading is being done on Jersey Avenue. The rock run is progressing. BOS signed the Secondary Roads Union Contract. The contract will take effect July 1, 2017.

Motion by Paulus, second by Walk to approve the minutes of the June 13th meeting. Roll call vote: all ayes.

Motion by Walk, second by Paulus to approve placing \$136,515.69 in the Conservation Land Acquisition & Capital Improvement Fund. \$432.94 from Restitution, \$3,050.00 from Burn, \$7,335.88 from Seeding, \$394.52 from Cans for Conservation and \$125,282.35 from Hoffman property reimbursement. Roll call vote: all ayes.

Discussed with Conservation Director Adam Shirley possible plans to take over the can redemption center. Adam will get quotes for a building to handle the can redemption at the Recycling Center. Adam also gave an update for the Conservation Department. Mitchell County Conservation has been approved for receiving \$350,000 for a FEMA culvert replacement project. Adam is considering on hiring a seasonal employee who has mechanic experience.

Items of note: Paulus reported on a Legislative meeting for Supervisors and Voaklander reported on the FMC Landfill meeting. Received a manure management plan updates from Jenkins North and South Finisher Farms, Johnson Nursery Unit, Kiss Finisher Farm, Liberty East, South and West Finisher Farms and Valley Finisher Farm.

Meeting adjourned at 9:53 a.m.
