

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Tuesday, October 12, 2021

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also, present were Paul Boerjan, Keith Horgen, Rich Brumm, Chuck Pajer, Greg Beaver, Sheri Penney, Jerry Phillips, and Kris Olson. Due to COVID 19 the meeting was made available by video via "Go to Meeting". Motion by Frein, second by Mayer to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Hendrickson, second by Wherry to approve the minutes of the October 5th meeting and claims. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

County Attorney Walk had nothing to discuss.

County Sheriff Beaver received a complaint from Alliant Energy on the Kephart property. Sheriff Beaver said the Kephart property nuisance is in the way of Alliant Energy being able to complete service. Attorney Walk stated he will send a letter to Kephart's attorney.

There was no department head discussion.

County Engineer Rich Brumm gave an update on the Bailey Bridge and said the anticipated start date of the Balsam Bridge will be the week of October 18th. Brumm mentioned a culvert near Klapperich Farm Systems that they will be replacing. Brumm discussed with WHKS last week the projects for Kirkwood Avenue and Hickory Avenue. Brumm would prefer using local money for these projects.

Motion by Frein, second by Mayer to approve the Recorder's Quarterly Report in the amount of \$25,930.26 for the Quarter ending September 30, 2021. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

Motion by Wherry, second by Smolik to approve the Auditor's Quarterly Report of Revenue in the amount of \$2,660.08 for the Quarter ending September 30, 2021. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

Items of Note: Wherry and Mayer reported on the Midwest Engineering update for the HVAC project at the Sheriff's Office. Smolik, Hendrickson, and Frein had nothing to report. Smolik stated the violent intruder training was a success and would like to put some kits put together for an emergency. Received the September Clerk of Court's Report in the amount of \$2,675.68. There were no public comments.

Motion by Mayer, second by Frein to adjourn the meeting. All voted aye. Meeting adjourned at 9:03 a.m.
