

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Monday, November 1, 2021

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also, present were Paul Boerjan, Rich Brumm, Jason Selby, Chuck Pajer, Kris Olson, Brent Chapman, and Adam Shirley. Due to COVID 19 the meeting was made available by video via "Go to Meeting". Motion by Wherry, second by Mayer to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Hendrickson, second by Frein to approve the minutes of the October 26th meeting. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

County Attorney Walk stated a preliminary lien search was completed on Kephart's property. Expected date of the lawsuit should be filed Tuesday or Wednesday of this week. Attorney Walk wanted to confirm the IPIB board decision was to dismiss the case. Auditor Foster discussed a voting situation that evolved at a nursing home in the County.

County Engineer Rich Brumm introduced Brent Chapman and explained Chapman is working with Austin Walk to complete the Weed Commissioner Report. Brumm discussed the Farm to Market balances to see how to pay for the Hickory Avenue and Kirkwood Avenue projects. Engineer Brumm gave updates on the Balsam Bridge and Bailey Bridge. Secondary Roads are currently working on patching and grading the roads.

Motion by Wherry, second by Mayer to approve the County Electronic Services System 28E Agreement with the Iowa County Recorders Association. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

Items of Note: Wherry reported on North Iowa Juvenile Detention, Mayer reported on Substance Abuse Coalition and Mitchell County Public Health, and Hendrickson reported on County Social Services. Smolik and Frein had nothing to report. There were no public comments.

Motion by Wherry, second by Mayer to adjourn the meeting. All voted aye. Meeting adjourned at 10:01 a.m.
