The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also, present were Paul Boerjan, Rich Brumm, Chuck Pajer, Keith Horgen, and Sheri Penney. Due to COVID 19 the meeting was made available by video via "Go to Meeting". Motion by Frein, second by Hendrickson to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Mayer, second by Wherry to approve the minutes of the November 23rd meeting. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

County Attorney Walk discussed the public hearing for vacating 400th Street, will need to be tabled with the newspapers not being able to publish on time with the holiday.

County Sheriff Beaver was not available.

Auditor Foster reminded all employees to have their sexual harassment and discrimination training completed by this Friday.
