

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Friday September 11, 2009

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:35 a.m. with all members present. Motion by Voaklander, second by Walk to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

The Board constituted themselves as a Board of Canvassers and proceeded to canvass the School Election held September 8, 2009. The results were as follows:

Osage Community School District – Two Director's at Large: Karla Mitchell received 210 votes, Neil M. Wubben received 186 votes, Dan VandenAvond received 98 votes and there was a scattering of 1 vote.

St. Ansgar Community School District – Director District #3: Pat Wagner received 33 write in votes and there were a scattering of 32 votes. Director District #4: Bryan Schupe received 140 votes and there were a scattering of 2 votes. Director District #5: Tara Bork received 88 votes, Tim Schulz received 66 write in votes and there were a scattering of 3 votes. Director District #6: Edward J. Kleinwort received 138 votes and there were a scattering of 4 votes.

NIACC Community College Director District #5: Gordon Anderson received 372 votes and there was a scattering of 1 vote.

Motion by Walk, second by Voaklander to approve the canvass and sign all abstracts pertaining to the election. Roll call vote: All ayes.

Discussed 532 ft. of damage done to the new paving on 430th Street east of Little Cedar. It was reported that the contractor has fixed the concrete road.
