The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Chuck Pajer and Jim Cross (Media). Motion by Walk, second by Voaklander to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Jerry Myers discussed the Masonic Grand Lodge ceremony for the cornerstone that is being donated by the Osage Masonic Lodge No. 102 scheduled for September 12th.

Tom Madden discussed sludge, final operations report, a 3rd tank and a permit for the Valent pretreatment plant.
