County Engineer Rich Brumm stated that the plans for the St. Ansgar shop building are out and a public hearing is scheduled for October 27th at 9:00 a.m. Bids are due on the 26th and will be opened after the public hearing. FEMA officials are coming on the 8th.

Motion by Voaklander, second by Paulus to approve the Auditor's Quarterly Report of Revenue in the amount of \$150.50. Roll call vote: all ayes.

Received a manure management plan update from Hufco – Mosher Ridge. Received the Second District Department of Correctional Services Annual Report for the year ended June 30, 2015.
