

Resolution #209

Whereas Chemical Dependency Services of North Iowa desires to construct a facility for the purpose of providing in-patient treatment, and other services to chemically dependent persons, and

Whereas the counties of Cerro Gordo, Floyd, Franklin, Hancock, Kossuth, Mitchell, Winnebago, and Worth, comprise the catchment area receiving services from C.D.S.N.I.

Therefore a multi-year, multi-county Community Development Block Grant was made and approved in the name of lead county Cerro Gordo in the amount of 900,000. to assist in the cost of construction of said facility.

Be It Recognized that in addition to the C.D.B.G. grant of 900,000., and 400,000. in the building account fund of C.D.S.N.I. fund raising efforts in the amount of 350,000. are needed to complete said project.

Now Be It Therefore Resolved that each of the aforementioned counties pledge financial support in a dollar amount equal to the population of their respective counties, according to the 1980 census, with that support to be included in F.Y.E. 1990-91 budget.

Be It Further Understood, assurances have been made by C.D.S.N.I. that if fund raising efforts exceed the target of 350,000. needed to complete the project, county contributions will be reduced proportionately.

We the county of Mitchell on this 3rd day of April, 1989, do hereby agree to pledge financial support in the amount of \$12,329.00, and to include that amount in our fiscal budget for the year ending June 30, 1991, contingent upon like contributions by each of the eight counties served in the catchment area.
