RESOLUTION

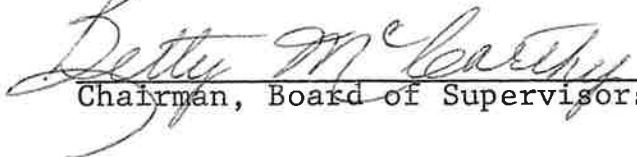
WHEREAS, Mitchell County, Iowa has acquired certain real estate formerly used as railroad right-of-way of the Chicago Northwestern Railway extending from Riceville to McIntire; and

WHEREAS, title to most of said railroad right-of-way remains in Mitchell County, Iowa; and

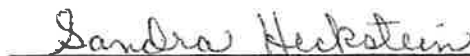
WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Supervisors that the property be used for conservation and public recreation purposes including, but not limited to the establishment and maintenance of a biking and hiking trail, cross country skiing and general nature conservancy;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the management of said real estate be placed in the Mitchell County Conservation Board for management in accordance with the foregoing stated purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no hunting shall be allowed on the property and that appropriate regulations to prohibit such shall be enacted by the Conservation Board.
