

RESOLUTION #256-92

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE REAPPORTIONMENT
OF COUNTY SUPERVISOR DISTRICTS IN
MITCHELL COUNTY

WHEREAS, under Section 331.209 of the Code of Iowa (1991), the County Board of Supervisors is required to divide the county into a number of supervisor districts corresponding to the number of supervisors in the county using the 1990 official census figures and

Whereas, the most recent federal decennial census has noted certain shifts of population within the county,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Supervisors of Mitchell County, Iowa, that the supervisor districts of Mitchell County be composed of the following:

DISTRICT #1 - First District shall consist of all of the city of Osage and the following sections or parts of sections in Osage township: 14, 15, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 35 and 36.
First District according to the 1990 census - 3670.

DISTRICT #2 - Second District shall consist of the following townships: Cedar, Rock, Mitchell, Newburg, St. Ansgar, Otranto, and in Union township, those sections west of County Road T36 except the North one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 15 and the North one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 16. Cities within those townships are Carpenter, St. Ansgar and Mitchell. Second District according to the 1990 census - 3642.

DISTRICT #3 - Third District shall consist of the following townships: Stacyville, Wayne, Liberty, Jenkins, Burr Oak, Douglas, West Lincoln, East Lincoln, and in Union Township those sections east of County Road T36 and the North one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 16 and the North one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 15. Third District shall also include the following sections or parts of sections in Osage township: 13, 17, 18, 19, 20, 29, 30, 31 and 32. Cities within those townships are Stacyville, McIntire, Riceville, and Orchard. Third District according to the 1990 census - 3616.

WHEREAS, certain deviations and standards must be met according to Iowa Code section 42.4, these are the deviations:

Total Mitchell County census 10,928 according to the 1990 census.
Ideal size of supervisors districts - 3643.

First District census	3670 - 3643 (ideal) = +27
Second District census	3642 - 3643 (ideal) = -1
Third District census	3616 - 3643 (ideal) = <u>-27</u>
Total deviation from ideal	55

There is no district that deviates from the 1% of the ideal district.
The overall deviation is not in excess of the 1% of total census.
The largest district divided by the smallest = .985 and therefore meets that criteria.
