WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration has established a program for creating district planning commissions in economically depressed areas, and

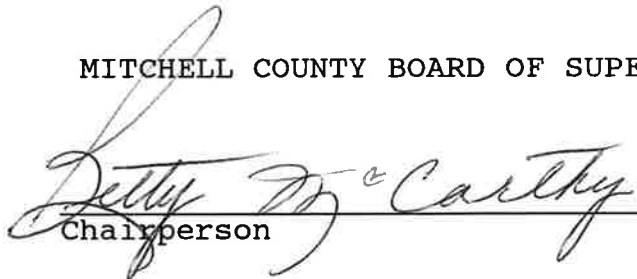
WHEREAS, the delineated planning Area II is eligible for participation with the Economic Development Administration as an economic development district, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapters 473A, 28E, and 28H, Code of Iowa, the units of local government within and including the counties of Cerro Gordo, Floyd, Franklin, Hancock, Kossuth, Mitchell, Winnebago, and Worth have formed a Council of Governments to direct, coordinate and review federal, state, and local programs of regional importance, said Council of Governments shall have the power to carry out the purposes defined by existing Intergovernmental Articles of Agreement.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mitchell County Board of Supervisors wishes to participate with the North Iowa Area Council of Governments, the Economic Development Administration, and the other counties in Area II (NIACOG region) for the purpose of establishing an economic development district.
