

RESOLUTION #262-92

WHEREAS, U.S. West Communications, Inc. has filed a tariff, identified as TF-92-28, to replace current emergency reporting service (E911) with a restructured service by unbundling features; and

WHEREAS, notices of the proposed increase in rates under this tariff were sent to E911 service boards, with proposed rate increases for counties of up to 585 percent in Humboldt County; and

WHEREAS, the Utilities Board, faced with a large number of counties filing objections to this tariff, has encouraged interested counties to coordinate their efforts to keep the number of intervening counties as small as possible, consistent with the representation of all significant viewpoints on the issues raised; and

WHEREAS, the tariff has been docketed for hearing and persons wishing to participate must file petitions to intervene by March 27, 1992; and

WHEREAS, the Iowa State Association of Counties has offered to represent the County in the tariff process;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Iowa State Association of Counties, 701 East Court Avenue, Des Moines, IA 50309 is hereby authorized to file a petition to intervene and otherwise act on behalf of the County before the Utilities Board regarding the tariff, identified as TF-92-28, filed by U.S. West Communications, Inc.
