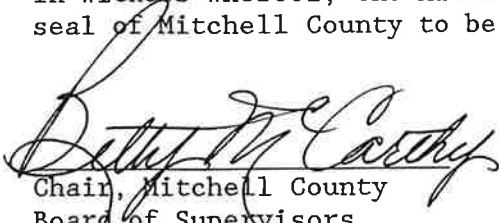
Whereas, JTPA Alumni (individuals who have successfully completed the program) who have overcome their barriers to employment and are now productive members of our community are the best advocates for the program;
