

RESOLUTION #282-92

WHEREAS: The Mitchell County Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Sections 321.236 and 321.255 of the Code of Iowa to designate any highway under their jurisdiction as a through highway and to erect STOP signs at specified entrances thereto, and,

WHEREAS: Route T-36 from the West $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of Section 35-100-17 north 4.5 miles to the N.W. Corner of Section 11-100-17 is functionally classed as a minor collector, and it being improved with a paved surface which is expected to attract additional traffic,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mitchell County Board of Supervisors that this resolution is to establish stop signs at the following intersections to stop all east-west traffic:

S.W. Corner of Section 23-100-17.

S.E. Corner of Section 22-100-17.

S.W. Corner of Section 14-100-17.

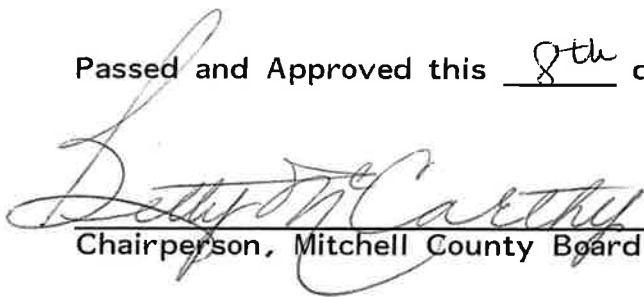
S.E. Corner of Section 15-100-17.

S.W. Corner of Section 11-100-17.

S.E. Corner of Section 10-100-17.

Also to stop north bound traffic at the N.W. Corner of Section 11-100-17.
