

RESOLUTION NO. 292-93

On the 22nd day of March, 1993, the Mitchell County Board of Supervisors met in regular session and the following resolution was moved and seconded:

WHEREAS, the Mitchell County Attorney's office anticipates the receipt of cash and/or property resulting from federal forfeitures of assets in cases in which the County Attorney's office has participated; and

WHEREAS, Federal regulations require that such cash and property be shared only where it will increase and not supplant law enforcement resources;

NOW THEREFORE, to maintain the eligibility of the Mitchell County Attorney's office to receive such funds and to comply with Federal regulations pertaining to the use of forfeited funds, be it resolved that there be created the Mitchell County Attorney Drug Enforcement Fund. That funds received by the County Attorney's office from state or federal agencies generated by asset forfeitures be placed therein and separately accounted for in said fund. That the Mitchell County Attorney Drug Enforcement Fund shall be a Special Revenue Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the fund be administered and used at the discretion of the Mitchell County Attorney in accordance with State and Federal regulations pertaining to the useage of such funds.

WHEREUPON, the question was called and passed.
