

RESOLUTION #293 - 93

MERGER OF LOCAL EMERGENCY PLANNING COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, Title III, Section 301, of the Emergency Planning and Community Right-To-Know Act (EPCRA) of 1986 establishes the Local Emergency Planning Committee; and

WHEREAS, the County has formed a LEPC as required; and

WHEREAS, each County is required to have an emergency plan on file with the State; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the merger of LEPCs would improve emergency planning efficiency and effectiveness; and

WHEREAS, such merger is allowed by state law; and

WHEREAS, the merger is required in order to submit joint grant applications; and

WHEREAS, each existing LEPC will continue to function as a sub-committee of the Regional Planning District;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mitchell County LEPC join with other LEPCs to form the NORTH CENTRAL REGIONAL EMERGENCY PLANNING DISTRICT. It is understood that each county must continue to develop and maintain a state reviewed emergency plan.

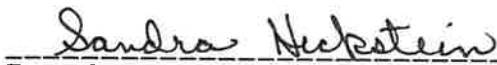

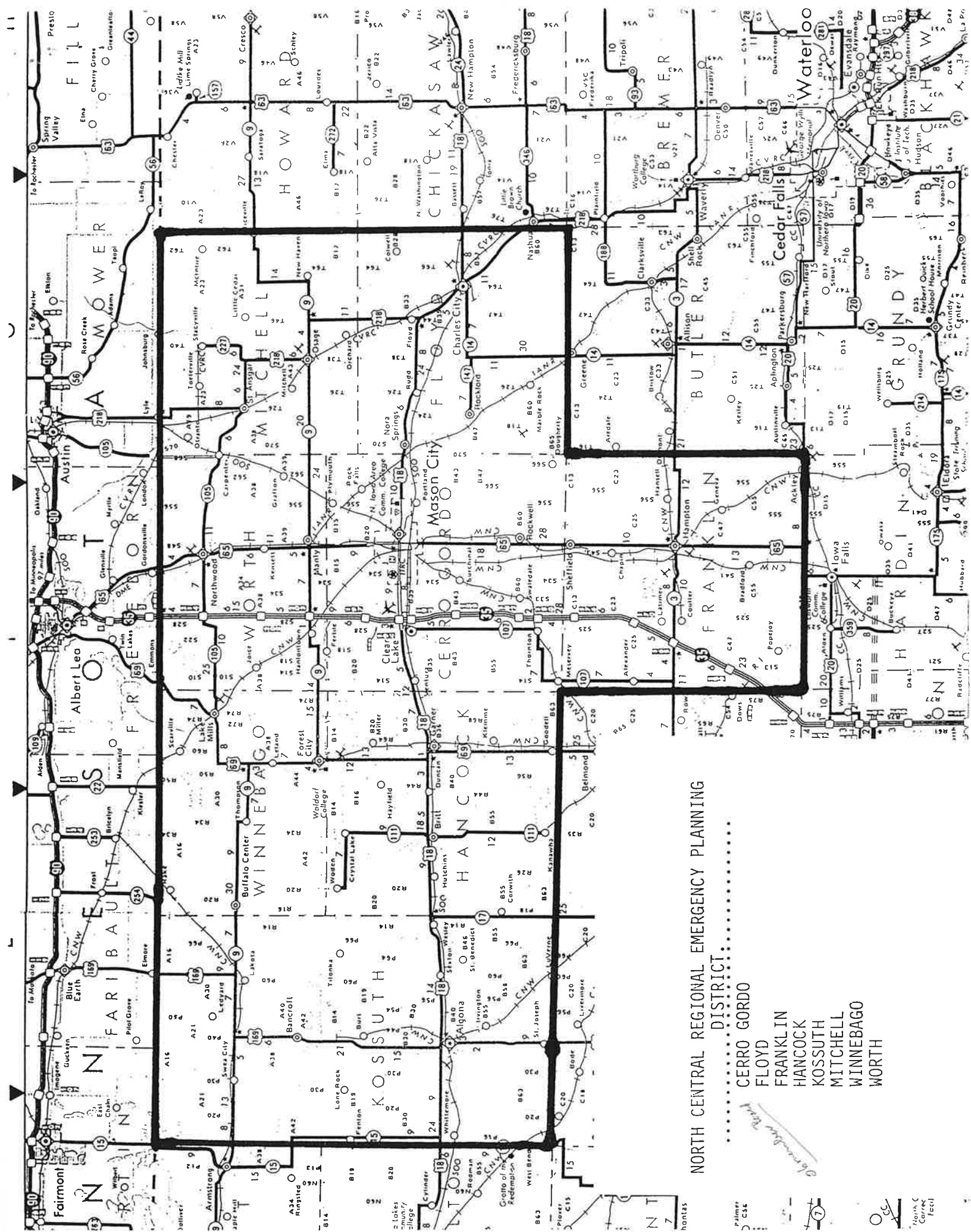
