MITCHELL COUNTY ORDINANCE # 3/

RDINANCE READOPTING THE EXISTING COUNTY CODE LL AMENDMENTS THERETO, MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

ACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Mitchell County, Iowa:

Section 1. <u>Purpose</u>. Code of Iowa §331.302(9), requires that once every five (5) years a County shall compile its Code of Ordinances. This ordinance readopts ordinances already in affect and adopts ordinances that become effective after the last readopting.

Section 2. Ordinance Repealed. The following previously-adopted ordinances, identified by ordinance number and subject matter, are hereby repealed, provided that a) any ordinance or part of an ordinance that was repealed by an ordinance hereby repealed shall not be enforceable or considered readopted and b) the repeal shall not operate to release or relinquish any penalty, forfeiture or liability incurred under each such ordinance, and each such repealed ordinance shall be treated as remaining in force for the purpose of instituting or sustaining any proper action or prosecution for enforcement of such penalty, forfeiture or liability:

Section 5. When Effective.	This ordinance shall be effective	after its final passage, approval
