

RESOLUTION #320-93

On the 22nd day of November 1993, at a regular meeting of the Mitchell County Board of Supervisors, the following resolution was moved and seconded:

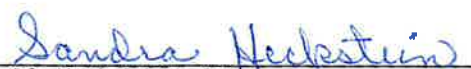
