

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Article VII of the 28E Agreement entered into between Mitchell County and Cerro Gordo County organizing A.L.I.A.S.U., the Advanced Law Enforcement Investigative and Administrative System Users, an organization created to facilitate the development and enhancement of a uniform computerized law enforcement records system, allows an amendment to be made to said Agreement upon approval by the Executive Committee or by the governing body of each of the local units of government participating in this Agreement if the amendment relates to financial matters; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board to amend Article IV, Page 2 of the aforementioned 28E Agreement and add a paragraph to read as follows:

"ALIASU recognizes the North Central Iowa Law Enforcement Consortium (NCILEC) as the developer of the ALIAS software and accepts from NCILEC the exclusive rights to market the ALIAS software understanding that 20% of any revenue from the sale of the ALIAS software shall be provided to NCILEC."

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors to adopt the foregoing resolution on this 23rd day of May, 1994 with the vote thereon being as follows:
