

MITCHELL COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 37
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MITCHELL COUNTY
ORDINANCE NO. 36

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL
COUNTY, IOWA:**

Mitchell County Ordinance No. 36 is hereby amended in the following particulars:

SECTION 1 – PURPOSE: is amended by striking the first paragraph and replacing it with the following language:

The purpose of this ordinance is to protect Mitchell County granular surface secondary roads during the time period from March 1st to May 29th for vehicles weighing in excess of 50,000 pounds which cause damage to the roads by repetitive trips over said road.

Mitchell County Ordinance No. 36 is hereby amended in the following particulars:

SECTION 4 – RESTRICTIONS: is amended by striking the first paragraph and replacing it with the following language:

It shall be unlawful for any owner(s) or operator(s) of any truck(s) or other commercial vehicle(s) whose weight is in excess of 50,000 pounds gross vehicle weight to travel on and cause damage by repetitive acts to granular surface secondary roads from March 1st to May 29th of any particular year. This Act does not apply to implements of husbandry as defined in Iowa Code §321.1.32, implements of husbandry loaded on hauling units for transporting the implements to locations for repair, and fire apparatus and road maintenance equipment owned by, under lease to, or used in the performance of a contract with a State or local authority.

ENACTMENT AND EFFECTIVE DATE

This amendment shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption as provided by law.
