RESOLUTION #386-96

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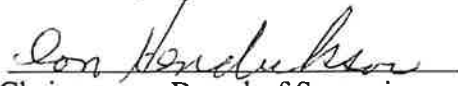
WHEREAS, Mitchell County as seller and Robert L. Bode as purchaser entered into a preliminary oral agreement for the sale and purchase, respectively, of real estate described as:

Lot Ten (10) and the alley between Lot Ten (10) on the South and Lot Three (3) on the North, all in Block One Hundred Forty-six (146), City of Osage, Iowa, according to the original plat, and according to Book 3 of Irregular Survey, Page 140 in the office of the Mitchell County Recorder; and

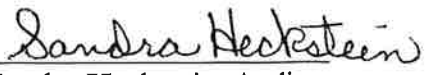
Lot Nine (9) and the alley between Lot Nine (9) on the South and Lot Four (4) on the North, all in Block One Hundred Forty-six (146), City of Osage, Iowa, according to the original plat, and according to Book 3 of Irregular Survey, Page 140 in the office of the Mitchell County Recorder.

WHEREAS, the required public hearing on the proposed sale was set for this same date and hearing has been held; and

WHEREAS, the proposed sale is in the best interest of the County; now therefore, be it resolved that the proposed sale of the above described property to Robert Bode as previously resolved in Resolution #381-96, be approved and that the county proceed with the sale as proposed.
