

RESOLUTION #392-96

WHEREAS: the Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Sections 321.236 and 321.255 of the Code of Iowa to designate any secondary road intersection under their jurisdiction as a STOP intersection and to erect STOP signs at one or more entrances to such intersection, and

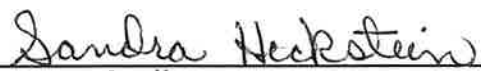
WHEREAS: traffic on 420th Street which is functionally classified as Local, is endangered by traffic from the south on Local road Jersey Avenue, at the intersection located at the NE Corner of Section 28, T99, R17W, because of terrain, which limits sight distance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mitchell County Board of Supervisors that the secondary road approach from the west be designated as a "STOP approach" to the above described intersection and that STOP sign shall be erected accordingly.
