

RESOLUTION NO. 428-98

On the 20th day of January, 1998, at a regular meeting of the Mitchell County Board of Supervisors, the following resolution was moved and seconded:

WHEREAS, the Mitchell County Memorial Hospital is currently undertaking a significant expansion of facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Mitchell County Home Health Care Agency has historically maintained, and currently does maintain its offices in the Mitchell County Memorial Hospital; and

WHEREAS, the Mitchell County Home Health Care Agency is a tax supported agency delivering health care services to the citizens of Mitchell County; and

WHEREAS, the Mitchell County Home Health Care Agency is experiencing a shortfall of revenues as a result of Medicare cutbacks; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the Hospital will provide office and clinic space to physicians and other health care providers at no charge or at a reduced charge;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mitchell County Board of Supervisors respectfully request the Trustees of the Mitchell County Memorial Hospital to provide adequate office space in the Mitchell County Memorial Hospital, at no charge, for the continued use of the Mitchell County Home Health Care Agency.
