RESOLUTION No. 431-98

WHEREAS, the North Iowa Area Council of Governments, a voluntary association of local governments established for the purpose of promoting intergovernmental cooperation and strengthening local units of governments, proposes to submit a funding application to the Iowa Department of Natural Resources under the Waste Tire Management County Grant Program; and

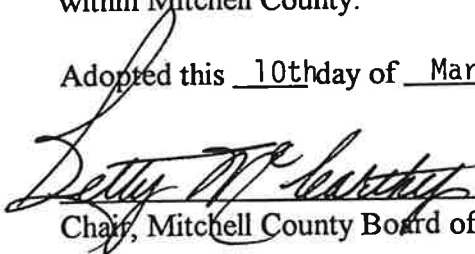
WHEREAS, a waste tire concern exists within Mitchell County for the proper disposal and management of waste tires; and

WHEREAS, Mitchell County desires to seek a grant allocation of \$15,000 under the Waste Tire Management County Grant Program to be awarded to a recipient for fiscal year 1999; and

WHEREAS, the Mitchell County Board of Supervisors may designate the North Iowa Area Council of Governments as its authorized designee;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mitchell County Board of Supervisors hereby designates the North Iowa Area Council of Governments as its official designee to secure grant funding through the Waste tire Management County Grant Program and develop a program for the education of Waste Tire Management in conjunction with the collection and disposal of waste tires within Mitchell County.

RE: Waste Tire Management Grant and Resolution

As you may recall, the North Iowa Area Council of Governments (NIACOG) administered a region wide waste tire amnesty (free pick-up) day last fall in conjunction with the DNR Waste Tire Management County Grant Program. The same grant program has been offered for fiscal year 1999 with the application deadline set for April 1, 1998. Staff has contacted your county representative for the waste tire committee. Your waste tire committee representative has expressed interest from the county in participating in the grant program again this year. Interest in the grant has been expressed by six of the eight north Iowa counties which participated in last years waste tire management program.

The proposed program to be submitted in the application will be structured similarly to last years very successful tire recycling day, with the exception of an increased emphasis on tire recycling education and awareness. In order for the committee to proceed with the application, the enclosed resolution must be adopted by the County Supervisors agreeing to let NIACOG represent your county in the application and stating that NIACOG will be the administrating body for the grant program. Please return, to NIACOG, the original signed copy of the adopted resolution. Thank you for your prompt consideration of this matter since the application deadline is April 1, 1998.
