WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration was assigned to administer the provisions of the Public Works and Economic Development Act of 1965; and

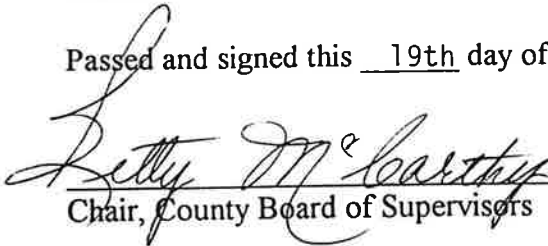
WHEREAS, the North Iowa Area Council of Governments has been designated as an Economic Development District under said act; and

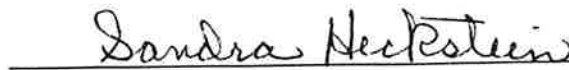
