

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Wednesday, January 14, 2026

The Board of Supervisors convened at 9:00 a.m. with Frein, Wherry, Marzen, and Hendrickson present. Hartogh was available via “Go to Meeting”. Also, present were Brandon Halsne, Lynn Hemann, Hannah Elliott, Shannon Paulus, and Laura Huisman. The meeting was made available by video via “Go to Meeting”. Motion by Hendrickson, second by Marzen to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Brandon Halsne went over his proposal for expenses and revenues for FY27. Halsne has proposed \$461,016 expenses, and \$2,000 revenues.

Hannah Elliot went over her proposal for expenses and revenues for FY27. Elliott has proposed \$238,098 expenses, and \$79,162 revenues.

Laura Huisman went over her proposal for General Assistance expenses for FY27. Huisman has proposed \$20,800 expenses.

Huisman went over her proposal for Public Health/Home Health expenses and revenues for FY27. Huisman has proposed \$1,380,971 expenses, and \$948,750 revenues.

Board of Supervisors went over their proposal for expenses for FY27. Board of Supervisors have proposed \$347,050 expenses.

The board would like to split maintenance, utilities, and salary by a third for the courthouse for fees to the courts. Auditor Foster discussed having a demonstration on a new software company on January 21st and asked no more than two board members to attend.

Frein adjourned the meeting at 10:35 a.m.
