Tuesday, January 26, 2021

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with Smolik, Wherry, Mayer, and Hendrickson present Todd Frein was available via Go To Meeting. Also present were Rich Brumm, Jason Smelby, Keith Horgen and Sammi Scharper. Due to COVID 19 the meeting was made available by video via "Go to Meeting". Motion by Wherry, second by Mayer to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Hendrickson, second by Mayer to approve the minutes of the January 19th meeting. All voted aye.

County Attorney Walk had nothing to report.

County Sheriff Beaver was not available.

County Engineer Rich Brumm went over the handout given to board members regarding snow complaints. Engineer Brumm requests all snow related complaints to contact secondary roads directly.

At 9:00 a.m. the Chair opened the public hearing to amend the FY 20/21 County Budget. The Chair asked if there were any oral or written comments received prior to the hearing. It was stated that none were received. The Chair reviewed the revenues and the expenses changes for the budget amendment.
