

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Tuesday, February 10, 2026

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with Frein, Wherry, Marzen, and Hendrickson present. Hartogh was available via "Go to Meeting". Also, present were Brandon Halsne, Greg Beaver, Aaron Murphy, Rich Brumm, Keith Horgen, and Rebekah Barr. The meeting was made available by video via "Go to Meeting". Motion by Marzen, second by Wherry to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Hendrickson, second by Wherry to approve the minutes of the February 3rd meeting & claims. Roll call: all voted aye.

County Attorney Murphy had nothing to present.

County Sheriff Beaver provided an Attorney General's opinion on the Sheriff's "Back the Blue".

There was no department head discussion.

County Engineer Rich Brumm will be gone for the next two days for federal aid training in Boone.

Motion by Wherry, second by Hendrickson to appoint Layton Zbornik as the NIACOG Board-City Representative. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

Motion by Marzen, second by Hartogh to approve Recorder's Report for January in the amount of \$15,177.97. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

Motion by Wherry, second by Marzen to approve Treasurer's Report for January in the amount of \$2,569,696.88. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

Motion by Marzen, second by Wherry to approve test giver increase of \$0.50 and increase \$0.66 to align with courthouse clerk pay for Noralba Blocker. Wherry noted pay will be \$21.16 per hour. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

There was discussion on possibly switching to a new software program. Supervisor Wherry talked about a committee meeting to talk through the process and timeframe logistics. The migration costs would come from the sub-project fund. Motion by Wherry, second by Marzen to approve ReGov Software Program Agreement. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

Supervisor Wherry provided an update on the Faith Lutheran Home Phase 1 Project. Faith Lutheran Home plans to do their project in phases, instead of one upfront cost. Dorsey stated the board is in a position to award the grant to Faith Lutheran Home upon completion of Phase 1 of the project without amending the existing grant agreement. Supervisor Marzen shared concerns about the project costing \$1 million versus the \$8 million that was approved.

Motion by Frein, second by Wherry to approve North Iowa Regional Housing Authority Payment in Lieu of Taxes Waiver Request. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

Frein reported on Fair Board, and Hendrickson reported on Iowa Workforce. Wherry, Hartogh, and Marzen had nothing to present. Received manure management plan updates from Meyer Site, Kuper Hog Site 2, and Kuper Cattle. Keith Horgen asked if the board could email him protocol eligibility for alignment to St. Ansgar City Hall.
