

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Tuesday, May 2, 2023

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also, present were Paul Boerjan, Aaron Murphy, Greg Beaver, Amanda Baer, Dale Goodale, Mike Miner, and Jennifer Backer. The meeting was made available by video via "Go to Meeting". Motion by Hartogh, second by Mayer to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Hendrickson, second by Frein to approve the minutes of the April 24th & April 25th meeting. Roll call: all voted aye.

County Attorney Murphy updated the S&H Environmental agreement with the City of Carpenter. Murphy is finishing paperwork for the public hearing on a new Ordinance next week.

County Sheriff Beaver stated summer events kick off this weekend in Riceville. Beaver plans to use as many reserves as possible for these events. Sheriff Beaver stated the 2023 vehicle is in at Karl Chevrolet, and they will take possession in July.

Amanda Baer said there is a Zoning Commission meeting tomorrow night at 5:30 p.m. regarding the wind turbine ordinance. Laura Huisman asked for an update on the camera situation. Supervisor Mayer asked for an update on the generator for Public Health.

County Engineer Rich Brumm was not available.

Motion by Frein, second by Hartogh to approve an In-Fill Lot application for Pickar-Oulman LLC in the amount of \$8,195. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

The Board of Supervisors agreed the In-Fill Lot Program has been of benefit to Mitchell County. Motion by Hartogh, second by Wherry to approve adding \$50,000 from LOSST to the In-Fill Lot Program. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

Motion by Mayer, second by Hendrickson to approve the new hire for Planning & Zoning while Baer is out on maternity leave for \$15 per hour. Roll call vote: all voted aye. The Planning & Zoning new hire will begin on May 16, 2023, to start training.

Items of Note: Mayer reported on Substance Abuse Coalition and Mitchell County Public Health, and Hendrickson reported on Iowa Workforce. Wherry, Hartogh, and Frein had nothing to report. Received manure

management plan updates from Jon Krebsbach Finisher, Jax Dairy, Iowa Select – Lipson Finisher Farm, and Iowa Egg Company. There were no public comments.
