

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Tuesday, May 19, 2026

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also, present were Justin Trees, Aaron Murphy, Greg Beaver, Keith Horgen, Tom Rolfes, Brandon Halsne, Jenny Backer, Rich Brumm, Mike Miner, Rebekah Barr, Guadalupe Bandillo, and Pat Mackin. The meeting was made available by video via "Go to Meeting". Motion by Wherry, second by Hartogh to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Marzen, second by Hendrickson to approve the minutes of the May 12th meeting. Roll call: all voted aye.

County Attorney Murphy had nothing to discuss.

County Sheriff Beaver had nothing to present. Deputy Justin Trees stated there was an accepted offer for the jail captain position, they are conducting third shift interviews this week, and there will be tests on June 6th for the deputy sheriff position.

Mike Miner provided an update after the Conservation Board meeting last week. Miner gave a campground renovation plans update, water trailer project update, said there was a memorial plaque donated for Jon Koster, and had job postings. Supervisor Marzen stated tomorrow is the Summer Kickoff Event at the Fairgrounds from 3:30-6:30 p.m.

County Engineer Rich Brumm gave an update on Addison Avenue and is still working on bridges for the grant. Brumm plans to get the rock run quote sent out this week.

Motion by Marzen, second by Hendrickson to approve PILOT Contract for Simple Mining. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

Hendrickson reported on Iowa Workforce, and Marzen reported on Conservation. Wherry, Hartogh, and Frein had nothing to report. Marzen read a letter from Summit Carbon Solutions stating their updated filing with IUC removes the route through Mitchell County.
