

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Monday, June 6, 2022

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Chuck Pajer, Greg Beaver, and Paul Boerjan. Due to COVID 19 the meeting was made available by video via "Go to Meeting". Motion by Wherry, second by Mayer to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Smolik, second by Hendrickson to approve the May 31st meetings minutes. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

County Attorney Murphy is reviewing documents for Auditor Foster. Supervisor Mayer asked about the Carpenter Sewer and what the County needs to do for homeowners to pay their bill.

County Sheriff Beaver said their office will be helping Riceville with their testing for a police officer. Beaver stated the state jail inspection will be getting completed. Sheriff Beaver will look up a price for their truck to sell to the City of Riceville. Beaver discussed a truck equipment bill that will be coming through for the new truck. The Sheriff's Office is looking for a part time jailer.

County Engineer Rich Brumm gave a painting update and Balsam bridge update via Go To Meeting. Brumm stated the used motor graders will be arriving this week. Brumm said the last half of the salt order is coming. Supervisor Mayer asked about installing speed limit signs for Carpenter, Brumm will get in contact with the City of Carpenter.

Motion by Hendrickson, second by Smolik to approve changing the bereavement policy for spouse and children to five days from three. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

Items of Note: Wherry, Smolik, Mayer, Hendrickson, and Frein had nothing to report. Received Manure Management Plan Update from Mark Patterson. There were no public comments.

Motion by Wherry, second by Frein to adjourn the meeting. All voted aye. Meeting adjourned at 8:53 a.m.
