

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Tuesday, August 6, 2024

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:36 a.m. with all members present, except Mike Mayer. Also, present were Rich Brumm, Aaron Murphy, Shannon Paulus, Penny Morse, Russ Brandau, and Ryan Stephen. The meeting was made available by video via "Go to Meeting". Motion by Hartogh, second by Frein to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Wherry, second by Hartogh to approve the minutes of the July 30th meeting. Roll call vote: All voted aye.

County Attorney Murphy had nothing new to report.

County Sheriff Beaver was not present.

Supervisor Hendrickson stated the Assessor's Office does not want the used pickup from the Sheriff's Dept., so it is open to other departments. Shannon Paulus stated tax statements are available online and hard copies should go out within the next 10 days.

County Engineer Rich Brumm said he would like to purchase the used truck from the Sheriff's Dept. and the salt shed base will be finished soon. No damage that he is aware of during last night's storm.

Motion by Hartogh, second by Frein to approve the Treasurer's Monthly report for July in the amount of \$1,245,907.09. Roll call vote: All voted aye.

Hendrickson reported on Iowa Workforce Development and County Social Services. Wherry, Hartogh, and Frein had nothing to report.

Public comment was made by Russ Brandau regarding TIF and borrowing against futures.
