

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Tuesday, August 23, 2022

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with Frein, Wherry, Smolik, and Hendrickson present and Mayer available on "Go to Meeting". Also present were Paul Boerjan, Keith Horgen, Greg Beaver, Jennifer Backer, Rich Brumm, and Randy Conrad. The meeting was made available by video via "Go to Meeting". Motion by Smolik, second by Frein to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Hendrickson, second by Smolik to approve the August 16th meeting minutes with adding the roll call vote to the new website design and claims. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

County Attorney Murphy was available via "Go to Meeting" and stated he has read through the proposed ordinance and public notice.

The Board of Supervisors discussed rates for disconnection and re-connection fees for the Carpenter Sewer. Motion by Frein, second by Hendrickson to set a public hearing date for proposed Ordinance #57 for September 13, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

County Sheriff Beaver reported on the complaints his office took during the Main to Main event this past weekend. Beaver explained a FedEx truck going into the ditch due to improper signage during the Main to Main event.

Supervisor Hendrickson stated he would make a drive to Des Moines if Public Health was interested in the extra PPE they have available.

County Engineer Rich Brumm gave a Kirkwood Avenue update. Brumm does not have a beginning date for bridge north of Stacyville. Engineer Brumm would like to find a better solution for next year's Main to Main marathon. Supervisor Smolik asked for Brumm to look at the rock west of Dan Swann's place.

Items of Note: Frein reported on Mitchell County Economic Development Commission, and Hendrickson reported on Wellness. Wherry, Smolik, and Mayer had nothing to report. Received the July Clerk of Court's Report in the amount of \$1,193.46. There were no public comments.

Motion by Smolik, second by Hendrickson to adjourn the meeting. All voted aye. Meeting adjourned at 09:03 a.m.
