

# PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Tuesday, September 20, 2022

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Paul Boerjan, Keith Horgen, Aaron Murphy, Greg Beaver, and Jennifer Backer. The meeting was made available by video via "Go to Meeting". Motion by Smolik, second by Hendrickson to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Frein, second by Wherry to approve the September 13<sup>th</sup> meeting minutes. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

County Attorney Murphy explained how a special assessment would work for the Carpenter Sewer. Murphy is going to look at the 28E Agreement to possibly update the wording where Mitchell County would receive the total monthly payment every month for the Carpenter Sewer versus just being paid for the homeowners that paid for the month.

County Sheriff Beaver discussed possibly adding FT jailers next budget year as it is hard to keep shifts filled with part time jailers. Sheriff Beaver stated the Riceville police officer started yesterday and the City of Riceville is requesting we fulfill our contract with them until the end of the calendar year.

Auditor Foster suggested updating the maintenance job description as it is outdated. Supervisor Mayer, Supervisor Frein, Foster and Sheriff Beaver will work on updating the job description for maintenance. Supervisor Hendrickson asked if ATV tickets have gone up, Beaver stated they have not.

At 9:00 a.m. the Chair opened the public hearing for Ordinance #57. The Chair read Ordinance #57 and asked if there were any written or oral comments received prior to the hearing. The Board and Auditor Foster replied that none were received. The public in attendance had no comments. Public hearing was closed at 9:03 a.m.

Motion by Wherry, second by Smolik to waive the first and second readings of Ordinance #57. Roll call vote: all voted aye. Motion by Hendrickson, second by Smolik to approve Ordinance #57. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

County Engineer Rich Brumm was available on "Go To Meeting" and had nothing to update.

Items of Note: Wherry reported on 2<sup>nd</sup> Judicial, and Smolik reported on Wapsi Watershed. Mayer, Hendrickson and Frein had nothing to report. There were no public comments.

Motion by Smolik, second by Wherry to adjourn the meeting. All voted aye. Meeting adjourned at 09:16 a.m.
