

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Monday, November 7, 2022

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Paul Boerjan, Randy Conrad, Greg Beaver, Aaron Murphy, Dave Stauffer, Shannon Paulus, and Jennifer Backer. The meeting was made available by video via "Go to Meeting". Motion by Wherry, second by Hendrickson to approve the agenda. All voted aye.

Motion by Hendrickson, second by Frein to approve the November 1st meeting minutes and claims with correcting the claim to Ketelsen Construction to \$5,000. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

County Attorney Murphy was busy last week with criminal trials and wanted to thank the Sheriff's Office for doing a fantastic job.

County Sheriff Beaver received a unanimous donation of \$7,000 that will be used to update body armor and medical gear. Beaver stated they have housed an inmate from Missouri with medical bills reaching \$6,000. Beaver is going to try and have Missouri pay.

Treasurer Shannon Paulus stated 99% of the first half of taxes have been collected, and 12% of the second half of taxes have been collected. Paulus said this is the last year to deduct real estate on your taxes. Paulus explained the County earned the 5% discount for Wellness. Auditor Foster asked if the Supervisors would prefer having Elderbridge meet in person or send their annual report. Supervisors would like to meet every other year. Supervisor Wherry gave a HVAC update.

County Engineer Rich Brumm was not available. Supervisor Wherry stated the paving in Stacyville should begin next week.

Motion by Smolik, second by Mayer to approve the 28E agreement with DOT for driver's license. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

Items of Note: Mayer reported on Mitchell County Public Health. Wherry, Smolik, Hendrickson, and Frein had nothing to report. Received a manure management plan update from Shoger Site. Attorney Murphy also thanked the Osage Police Department for their help with the criminal cases. Supervisor Smolik thanks the unanimous donor for the donation to the Sheriff's department.

Motion by Smolik, second by Wherry to adjourn the meeting. All voted aye. Meeting adjourned at 08:53 a.m.
