

# PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MITCHELL COUNTY, IOWA

Tuesday, February 19, 2019

The Board of Supervisors convened at 8:30 a.m. with all members present. Also present were Chuck Pajer, Dean Pohren, Randy Conrad, Al Winters, Duane Tesch, Joy Beckman, Adam Shirley, Chelsea Rowcliffe and Chrystal Berche (Media). Motion by Walk, second by Francis to approve the agenda. All ayes.

Motion by Francis, second by Walk to approve the minutes of the February 12th meeting. Roll call vote: all voted aye.

Motion by Francis, second by Walk to approve Resolution #1028-19 authorizing the sharing of the position of Mental Health Advocate, Angela Nasstrom, with Cerro Gordo County. Roll call vote: all ayes.

County Attorney Mark Walk discussed the Wellness Participation Resolution. County Attorney has received concerns from County employees regarding fees being charged for those who don't participate. This will be looked at further.

Sheriff Greg Beaver presented the Sheriff Report for January. Motion by Francis, second by Walk to approve the report in the amount of \$7,208.08. Roll call vote: all ayes.

Gayle Nelson discussed the Main to Main Marathon scheduled for August of 2019. Discussed closing Foothill Avenue, signage for the event and safety concerns.

County Engineer Rich Brumm stated that he had received a resignation from one of the road workers. Roads department has 500 tons of salt left for the winter.

Brian Retterath gave his views and support on why Quail Avenue should be included for the County's paving program. Engineer Brumm explained the paving points system and funding for farm to market roads. Others in attendance showed their support for paving Quail Avenue and to encourage culvert work. No action was taken.

Conservation Director Adam Shirley gave an update on Riverside Park at Stacyville. Adam is providing the Board with copies of future Conservation projects.

Items of note: Francis reported on the North Iowa Juvenile Detention meeting and Smolik reported on the Valent and FMC Landfill meetings. Received the Clerk of Court Report for January in the amount of \$3,144.44. .
